COURSES OFFERED AT CENTRE FOR EUROPEAN STUDIES – SPRING 2011/12

Registration: Students should initially go to classes which they would like to attend (classes begin **February 23**). Students must register online at <https://www.usosweb.uj.edu.pl> during the second week of classes, in the period: **March 5, 10am – March 7, 4pm**, using their university login and password provided by the International Students Office. Students **must then register in person** at the CES office at Garbarska 7a. International students enrolled at the Institute of European Studies will have priority over students enrolled elsewhere, and places will then be decided based on time of online registration. The CES Registrar will inform students by email which courses they have been granted a place in.

Students who wish to withdraw from a course in which they are enrolled **must** do so online at <https://www.usosweb.uj.edu.pl> and in person at the CES office by **March 15 at 4pm at the latest.**

Students who are not given a place should check the course registration list in the USOS system to see whether any places become free before the above deadline for withdrawal (March 15 at 4pm). If a place becomes available they may request to register for the course in person at the CES office.
